

## HOMEMAKER

**DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:** This is routine work in performing homemaking services, which can include children care. This work is necessary where a household is in need of this type of service because of absent parents, illness, and/or an infirmity depriving householders the means in providing for their needs. The work is generally assigned by a superior employee who provides general direction and, if needed, immediate supervision for work assignments. Does related work as required.

**TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:**

- Cares for children including supervising their diet, health, department and recreation;
- Takes care of family clothing including laundering, ironing and occasionally repairing/sewing clothing;
- Plans and prepares meals for the family, and may do marketing;
- Cleans, dusts, washes dishes and performs a variety of other housekeeping tasks to keep the home in a sanitary and livable condition;
- Advise mothers in household management and in baby care;
- May care for elderly people or disabled, handicapped, ill or convalescent persons (except nursing care);
- When assigned, may provide transportation services and assistance to clients in grocery shopping, doctor visits, dentists and opticians, and in other needy situations;
- Reports unusual situations or conditions requiring special attention to Caseworkers and other interested and involved social service employees.

**FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES & PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS**

Working knowledge of the geography of the county and the locations of various public and private agencies, shopping centers and health facilities; ability to understand and carry out written and oral instructions; ability to perform housekeeping activities; ability to care for children; ability to get along well with others; initiative and resourcefulness; industry and dependability; discretion, tact and good judgment; good moral character; neat appearance; emotional stability; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

**Either –**

(A) Graduation from high school or the possession of a high school equivalency diploma and two years of experience in homemaking activities including children care;

**OR**

(B) Six years of homemaking activities including children care;

**OR**

(C) An equivalent combination of training and experience within the limits of (A) & (B).

**SPECIAL REQUIREMENT:** Certain assignments made to employees in this class will require access to transportation to meet fieldwork requirements made in the ordinary course of business in a timely and efficient manner.
